#### SIZE

XS (S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3X)

To fit bust: 81 (86, 91, 97, 102, 107, 112) cm

Length from shoulder: 54 (56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61) cm

Sleeve seam: 44cm for all sizes

#### **MATERIALS**

Manos del Uruguay Serena (60% Baby Alpaca, 40% Pima

Cotton), 155m/170yds per 50g Shown in 5004 Dancing Jewel 5 (**5**, 5, **6**, 6, **6**, 7) x 50g skeins

4mm (US 6) straight needles, or size needle to obtain

gauge

Spare 4mm (US 6) needles 3.25mm (US 3) straight needles

Cable needle Stitch markers Tapestry needle 9 buttons

#### **TENSION**

20 sts and 30 rows in a 10cm square measured over st st on larger needles

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

alt: alternate
beg: beginning

**C6:** slip next 2 sts on cable needle to back of work, k1, now k2 from cable needle, now slip next st on cable needle to front of work, k2, then k1 from cable needle

**CBP:** slip next st on cable needle to back of work, K1,

now P1 from cable needle

**CFP:** slip next st on cable needle to front of work, P1,

now k1 from cable needle

CBK: slip next st on cable needle to back of work, k1,

now k1 from cable needle

CFK: slip next st on cable needle to front of work, k1,

now k1, from cable needle.

cont: continue
cm: centimetres

dec: decrease, decreasing

foll: following

inc: increase, increasing

k: knit
p: purl
patt: pattern
rem: remain(ing)
rep: repeat

**RS/WS:** right side/wrong side facing

st(s): stitch(es)
st st: stocking stitch

## Panel (worked over 12 sts)

**1st row:** P5, CFK, p5.

**2nd and every alt row:** Work across 12 sts knitting all k sts and purling all p sts.

**3rd row:** P4, CBP, CFP, p4. **5th row:** P3, CBP, p2, CFP, p3. **7th row:** P2, CBP, p4, CFP, p2. **9th row:** P2, CFP, p4, CBP, p2. **11th row:** P3, CFP, p2, CBP, p3. **13th row:** P4, CFP, CBP, p4.

**13th row:** P4, CFP, CBP, p4. **15th row:** P5, CFK, p5. **17th row:** P4, CBK, CFK, p4. **19th row:** P3, CBK, k2, CFK, p3. **21st row:** P2, CBK, k4, CFK, p2.

**23rd row:** P2, CFP, k4, CBP, p2. **25th row:** P3, CFP, k2, CBP, p3. **27th row:** P4, CFP, CBP, p4. **28th row:** K5, p2, k5.

These 28 rows form panel.

#### Back

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 101 **(107,** 113, **119,** 125, **131,** 137) sts.

**1st row:** K2, (p1, k1) to last st, k1.

**2nd row:** K1, (p1, k1) to end.

Rep the last 2 rows twice more, inc 1 st at each end of last row.

103 **(109,** 115, **121,** 127, **133,** 139) sts

Change to 4mm needles and patt as follows:

**1st row (RS):** K15 (**16**, 17, **18**, 19, **20**, 21), \*p2, C6, work 1st row of panel, C6, p2\*, k17 (**21**, 25, **29**, 33, **37**, 41), work from \* to \*, k15 (**16**, 17, **18**, 19, **20**, 21).

**2nd row:** P15 (**16**, 17, **18**, 19, **20**, 21), \*k2, p6, work 2nd row of panel, p6, k2\*, p17 (**21**, 25, **29**, 33, **37**, 41), work from \* to \*, p to end.

**3rd row:** K15 (**16**, 17, **18**, 19, **20**, 21),\*p2, k6, work 3rd row of panel, k6, p2\*, k17 (**21**, 25, **29**, 33, **37**, 41), work from \* to \*, k to end.

**4th row:** P15 (**16**, 17, **18**, 19, **20**, 21), \*k2, p6, work 4th row of panel, p6, k2\*, p17 (**21**, 25, **29**, 33, **37**, 41), work from \* to \*, p to end.

**5th to 28th rows:** Rep 1st to 4th rows 6 times but working 5th to 28th rows of panel.

These 28 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until back measures 39cm from beg, ending after a WS row.

## **Shape Armholes**

Cast off 6 (**7**, 8, **8**, 9, **10**, 11) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row until 75 (**79**, 83, **87**, 89, **93**, 97) sts rem.

Cont straight until work measures 54 (56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61)



cm, ending after a WS row.

#### **Shape Shoulders**

Keeping patt correct, cast off 8 (8, 9, 9, 9, 10, 11) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 8 (9, 9, 10, 10, 10, 10) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Slip rem 27 (**29**, 29, **31**, 33, **33**, 33) sts on a spare needle.

# Right Front

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 49 (**53**, 55, **59**, 61, **65**, 67) sts.

Work 6 rows in rib as on back, but inc 1 st at side edge on last row on 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th sizes only. 50 (53, 56, 59, 62, 65, 68) sts

Change to 4mm needles and place patt as follows: **1st row (RS):** K7 **(9**, 11, **13**, 15, **17**, 19), p2, C6, work 1st row of panel, C6, p2, k15 **(16**, 17, **18**, 19, **20**, 21). **2nd row:** P15 **(16**, 17, **18**, 19, **20**, 21), k2,

P6, work 2nd row of panel, p6, k2, p7 (9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19).

Keeping panel correct, cont in patt working C6 cables spaced as on back, until front measures same as back to

armhole shaping, ending at side edge.

## Shape Armhole

Cast off 6 (**7**, 8, **8**, 9, **10**, 11) sts at beg of next row. Dec 1 st at armhole edge on next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row until 36 (**38**, 40, **42**, 43, **45**, 47) sts rem.

Cont straight until front measures 14 (**14**, 16, **16**, 18, **18**, 20) rows less than back up to shoulder shaping, ending at front edge.

# Shape Neck

Cast off 8 (9, 9, 10, 11, 11, 11) sts at beg of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 24 (25, 27, 28, 28, 30, 32) sts rem.

Cont straight until back measures same as front to shoulder shaping, ending at armhole edge.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off 8 (**8**, 9, **9**, 9, **10**, 11) sts at beg of next and foll alt row. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 8 (9, 9, 10, 10, 10, 10) sts.

### Left Front

Work to match right front noting that 1st row placing patt will be: K15 (16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21), p2, C6, work 1st row of panel, C6, p2, k7 (9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19).

## Sleeves (work both the same)

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 41 (**43**, 43, **45**, 47, **47**, 49) sts.

Work 6 rows in rib as on back, inc 1 st at end of last row. 42 (44, 44, 46, 48, 48, 50) sts

Change to 4mm needles and continue in st st with centre cable as follows:

**1st row (RS):** K16 (**17**, 17, **18**, 19, **19**, 20), p2, C6, p2, k16 (**17**, 17, **18**, 19, **19**, 20).

**2nd row**: P16 (**17**, 17, **18**, 19, **19**, 20), k2, p6, k2, p to end. **3rd row**: As 1st row, but working "k6" in place of "C6".

4th row: As 2nd row.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, shaping sleeve by inc 1 st at each end of next row, then on every foll 8th (6th, 6th, 6th, 6th, 4th, 4th) row until there are 66 (50, 66, 76, 78, 62, 70) sts, then on every foll 10th (8th, 8th, 8th, 6th, 6th, 6th) row until there are 70 (74, 78, 82, 86, 90, 94) sts, taking extra sts into patt. Cont straight until sleeve measures 44cm from beg, ending after a p row.

# Shape Top

Cast off 6 (**7**, 8, **8**, 9, **10**, 11) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row until 30 (**30**, 30, **34**, 34, **36**, 36) sts rem, then on every row until 22 (**22**, 22, **24**, 24, **26**, 26) sts rem. Cast off loosely.

#### Neckband

First join shoulders.

Using 3.25mm needles, and with RS facing, k up 25 (26, 28, 29, 32, 32, 34) sts evenly round right front neck, k across back neck sts, and finally k up 25 (26, 28, 29, 32, 32, 34) sts round left front neck.

77 (81, 85, 89, 97, 97, 101) sts

Beg with 2nd row, work 6 rows straight in rib as on back. Cast off firmly in rib.

#### **Borders**

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 9 sts. Work a strip in rib as

on back to fit up front edge to top of neckband, ending after a 2nd row and allowing for border to be slightly stretched. Cast off in rib.

Mark position on border for 9 buttons, first and last ones to be worked in 4th/5th rows from each end of border and remaining 7 spaced evenly between.

Now work buttonhole border to match button border, but working holes to match markers thus:

1st row (WS): Rib 3, cast off 2 sts, rib to end.

2nd row: Rib 4, cast on 2 sts neatly, rib 3.

### **Finishing**

Sew in sleeve tops.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Sew on borders and attach buttons.
