MANOS DEL URUGUAY

MEASUREMENTS

One size to fit an average lady's head

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Alegria Grande (75% superwash Merino/25% Polyamide), 180m/197yds per 100g,
1 x 100g hank
Shown in #8105 Cabaret
4mm (US #6) and 5mm (US #8) needles, or size to obtain correct tension

TENSION

18 sts and 24 rows in a 10cm (4in) square over stocking stitch using 5mm needles

ABBREVIATIONS

K: knit
P: purl
St(s): stitch(es)
Patt: pattern
Inc: increase, increasing
Dec: decrease, decreasing
Beg: beginning
Tog: together
Tbl: through back of loops
Alt: alternate
Rep: repeat
Cont: continue
Rem: remaining
RS or WS: right side or wrong side facing

INSTRUCTIONS

Using 4mm needles, cast on 81 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, (p1, k1) to last st, k1.

Row 2: K1, (p1, k1) to end.

Rep the last 2 rows once, then rep Row 1 again.

Next row: K1, p2, inc purlways twice in each of the next 3 sts, (inc purlways twice in next st, inc purlways in each of the next 3 sts) 18 times, p2, k1. (177 sts)

Change to 5mm needles.

Next row (RS): K3, (p3, k3) to end.

Next row: K1, p2, (k3, p3) to last 6 sts, k3, p2, k1.

Rep the last 2 rows until work measures 13cm (5in) from beg, ending after a RS row.

Next row: P2, (p2tog, k1, p2tog, k2) 25 times. (127 sts)

Shape Crown

Row 1: (K12, k2tog) 9 times, k1. (118 sts)

Row 2 & every alternate row: K1, p to last st, k1.

Row 3: (K11, k2tog) 9 times, k1. (109 sts)

Row 5: (K10, k2tog) 9 times, k1. (100 sts)

Continue this way dec 9 sts on every K row until the row "(K1, k2tog) 9 times, k1" has been worked. (19 sts)

Break yarn and run end through rem 19 sts.

Draw up securely and fasten off.

To make up

On WS press crown only, according to ball band instructions.

Join seam.
